

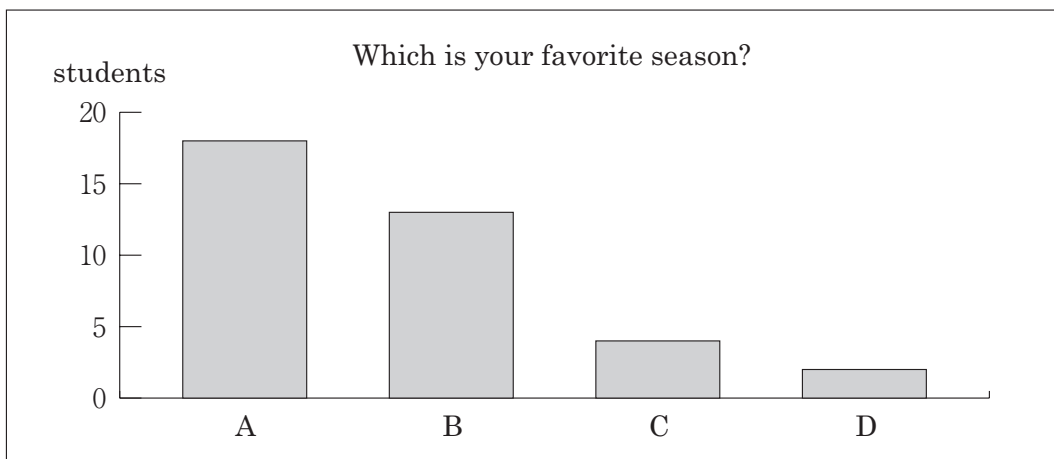

Asami: Thank you. Oh, the sweets of the café look delicious! Let's go together!

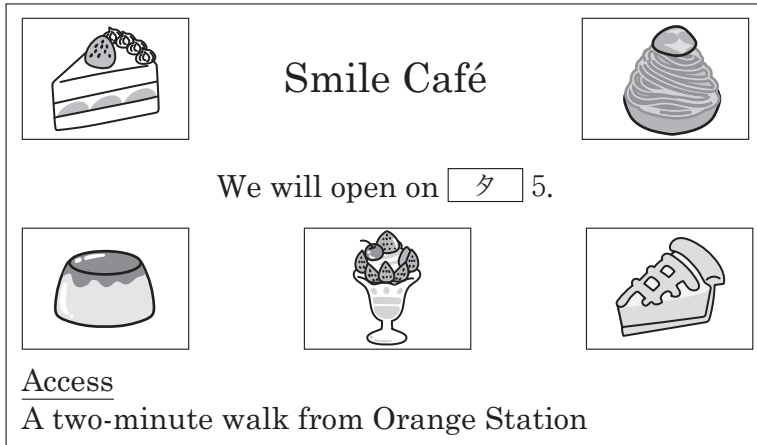
Cathy: Yes, let's go.

Asami: Well, I have never been to Orange Station. Is it near here?

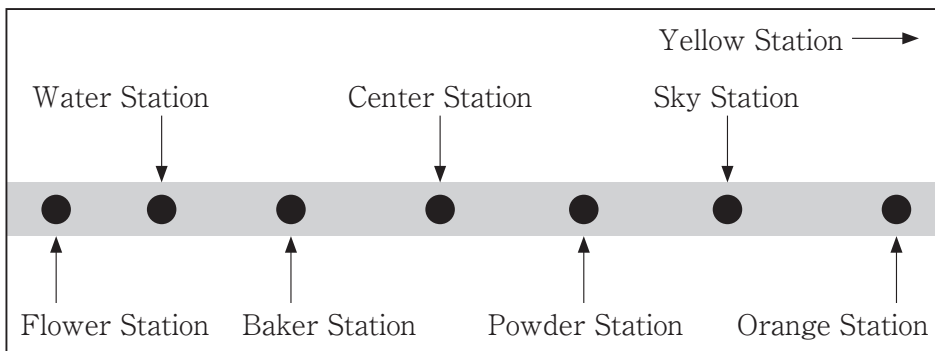
