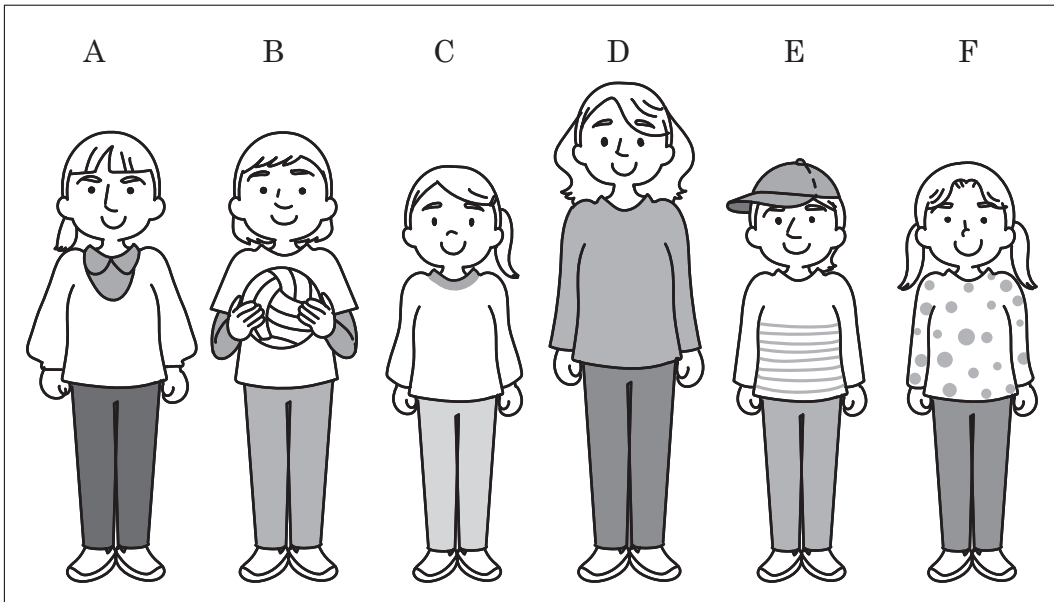

Saki : That's not bad, but I'm more interested in libraries with cafes because I've never been to such libraries.

Andy : OK. If you want to get to a library by bike, Green Library is good.

Saki : I don't have a bike, so either is good.

Andy : Then, let's go to Blue Library because its borrowing period is longer.

After watching the program, he said to his parents, “I want to adopt a dog from a group like that.” His mother answered, “Actually, I’ve been feeling the same way.” His father agreed, and together they started looking for volunteer groups that support abandoned dogs and found (あ) one that works near their house.

The next Saturday, Akito and his parents visited the group’s animal shelter. There were fourteen abandoned dogs there. Some of them liked people, but others didn’t. Among them, Akito was interested in a brown dog. Her big black eyes looked lonely, and she looked old. Akito said to one of the volunteers at the animal shelter, “I want to take this dog home.” The volunteer said, “Can you? She’s old and doesn’t really like people. It may be difficult to take care of her.” Akito answered, “I understand, but I want to choose her because she’s old. I think most people want younger dogs, so it may be hard for her to find a new family, and of course, I want to make her happy.” The volunteer asked his parents, “Is that OK?” They agreed.

To become the owner of one of the abandoned dogs there, people need to take care of the dog for two weeks as a trial. So Akito and his parents took the dog home for the trial. On their way home, Akito named her Fuku, because he wanted her to have lots of good luck.

At first, Fuku was (い) wary of Akito and his parents. However, thanks to their kindness, she began to feel safe with them little by little. She started to look happier. Akito was happy to see her. He wanted to ( う ) Fuku lots of good luck, but he also felt that she brought good luck to his family. On the last day of the trial, the volunteer came to see them.
